Dear Mr. Lediard, The committee of the Botanical Society may know that the Y.W.C.A. has this year opened a University Hall of Residence for women students, Jean Begg House, in the former Hotel Northland, next to the Y.W.C.A. in Queen Street.

A library, known as the Ella Spencer Library, has been started and I am writing to suggest that the committee of the Auckland Botanical Society consider presenting a book or books on botany to the library. Six botany students are in residence this year and any botany books should benefit an indefinite number of students in future years.
