VASCULAR PLANTS OF THE A.R.A. REGIONAL PARK, WAHARAU

A checklist of vascular plants of the Waharau Park, near Kaiaua was first made by an Auckland Bot. Soc. field trip in July 1980. A later field trip on 18th May 1985 was able to add a considerable number of species to this list, although this is still not regarded as being complete, and the identification of a few species is still in doubt. Only a few of the introduced species are included.
