

CLEMATIS HEXASEPALA

Clematis hexasepala is a plant of sunny banks and cliffs, of sortub, and of dry rocks above gorges. One form of it is particularly common on the central volcanic plateau, where it grows on a variety of rocks—greywacke, limestone and volcanic. The form growing about Wellington (and this may be the typical C. hexasepala) appears to be closely related to "C. colensoi." The nomenclature and taxonomy of this group are very much in need of a fresh study.
