



During the quarter century that has elapsed since the publications of *Flora of New Zealand* Volume 1, there have been considerable changes to the names of New Zealand plants. Some of our native plants have been placed in different families and genera, and many new species have been described and old species revived.

All these names have been collected together in '*Flora of New Zealand Name Changes*' where they are listed with commentaries on the taxonomic background underlying the name changes. The booklet is based on the 'Nomina Nova' series which appeared earlier in the *New Zealand Journal of Botany*. It includes as well, descriptions of some new species, and many combinations which are necessary because of generic realignment.
